## 7 Facts to Proclaim during your Veterans Day Program

Host a Veterans Day program or private commemoration during November 1-11 or October-November meetings. Inform participants and display this next to the poster:

- America's first Veterans Day was organized in Alabama in 1947 by Raymond Weeks, WW II veteran & former Alabama student.
- Alabama led the national movement after gaining support in 1946 from General Eisenhower, who as U.S. president established the federal holiday in 1954.
- The National Veteran Award was established in Birmingham in 1954.

- President Reagan honored Mr. Weeks with the Presidential Citizens Medal on national television at the White House in 1982.
- The United States Senate passed a resolution restoring the official historical roots of starting Veterans Day in Alabama in 2012.
- The book <u>Patriotism in Action</u> features the history of Veterans Day born in Birmingham plus 10 character traits and values to inspire students.
